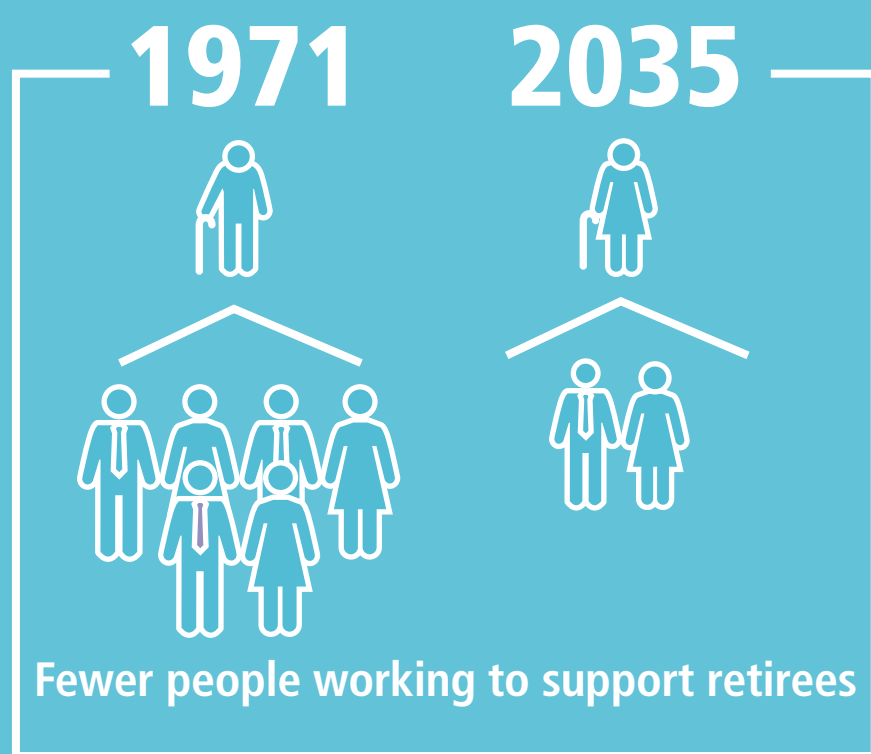

75%

3-year plan sets **MOST AMBITIOUS IMMIGRATION LEVELS** in recent history

This measured, gradual increase will **trend towards 1%** of the population by 2020
